# AD-200 1 Manual Door / 2-Way Tilt

### MACHINE OPERATION SUMMARY

This AD-200 incorporates one (1) Emergency Stop Button located on the right front control door (refer to the illustration on <u>page 3</u>). This button is either 'TURN TO RELEASE'' or 'PUSH-PULL' and must be in the released mode to power the machine. The Phase 5 microcomputer's display will light when the Emergency Stop Button is released. To turn on the AD-200's control voltage, press the green "ON" button located also on the right front control panel.

**NOTE**: If a Sprinkler System is incorporated in the machine, the Sprinkler System **must be** powered for the control power to engage. Refer to the <u>AD-200 Sprinkler System Manual</u> for Sprinkler System information.

The AD-200 has two (2) electronic controllers:

- Phase 5 micro-computer...for material drying.
- Micro-1 PLC (Programmable Logic Controller)...for jog and tilt control.

The Micro-1 PLC (Programmable Logic Controller) controls jog and tilt functions only when the AD-200 is not drying material.

"**LOAD - DRY - UNLOAD**" selector switch, located on the right front control door (refer to the illustration on **page 3**), is provided for loading and unloading the AD-200.

**IMPORTANT**: • The lint drawer **must be** closed prior to any tilting commands. Failure to close the lint drawer completely (to engage the lint drawer closed switch) will prevent any tilting command.

• Load Doors must be open prior to tilting forward or backward.

#### **AD-200 DETAILED OPERATION INFORMATION**

#### DRY ROUTINE

To dry material, the **'LOAD - DRY - UNLOAD**'' selector switch **must be** in the Dry Position, the front doors **must be** closed, and tumbler section level.

Anytime the airjet signal is asserted the **'END OF CYCLE**" light will begin to flash once a second and remain on until the load doors are opened.

#### LOAD/UNLOAD

#### "LOAD/UNLOAD" LEVEL

When the load doors are opened:

• The 'END OF CYCLE'' light will stop flashing.

**NOTE**: The manual jog feature operates in the level or tilted position.

#### "LOAD TILTED"

A "LOAD TILTED" selection will cause the following to occur:

- The tumbler section will tilt to the rear (front up).
- The manual jog function will allow the operator to jog the tumbler forward or reverse to load material into the tumbler.

#### "UNLOAD TILTED"

The 'UNLOAD TILTED' selection will cause the following to occur:

- The tumbler section will tilt to the front (rear up).
- The manual jog function will allow the operator to jog the tumbler forward or reverse to unload material from the tumbler.

#### "**DRY**"

If the machine is in the level position, the "DRY" selection will:

• Enable the Phase 5 Drying Selections, if the load doors are closed.

If the machine is in the tilted position, the 'DRY' selection will:

- Level the tumbler section.
- Enable the Phase 5 Drying Selections, if the load doors are closed.
